Baptism and Ministry Preparation of Jesus

Late Apr 29 AD	<u>John begins his ministry</u> (assumed to be in conjunction with the Week of Unleavened Bread, after his 30th birthday, which would have fit his message perfectly.)	<u>Matthew 3:1-12; Mark 1:2-8</u> <u>Luke 3:1-18; John 1:6-18</u>
Jul, 29 AD	<u>Jesus' Baptism</u> at "about 30"	<u>Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11;</u> <u>Luke 3:21-23a</u> (July 1 is assumed. It was 6/25+)
Jul, 29 AD	The <u>Temptations</u> in the Judean Wilderness Was for 40 days, primarily July	<u>Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12-13;</u> <u>Luke 4:1-13</u>
Aug 1, 29 AD	<u>Pontius Pilate</u> replaced <u>Valerius Gratus</u> (Josephus) May have been a political move by Praetorian Guard, who had taken command 2-3 yrs earlier	
Aug, 29 AD	<u>John Challenged</u> by the Priests at Bethany beyond the Jordan River	<u>John 1:19-28</u>
	<u>John Proclaims Jesus as Messiah</u> Publicly	<u>John 1:29-34</u>
	The <u>First Six Followers</u>	<u>John 1:35-51</u>
Late Aug 29 AD	The <u>Wedding</u> in Cana, Galilee	<u>John 2:1-12</u>
